Cricket Illawarra is delighted with the announcement that the first Sheffield Shield game to be held in Wollongong will be played at North Dalton Park on February 25-28 between NSW and Tasmania. This will be a major boost for the sport in the area. I firstly would like to thank Cricket NSW for allocating this game to Wollongong. It is vital that large regional cities are awarded games of this calibre. The three-year agreement between CNSW and Wollongong City Council will see other high profile fixtures played at NDP in the following two seasons.

Cricket has only been played at North Dalton Park since 1995, and long serving officials the late Ivor Ewin and Norm Warren, together with current CNSW Board member Ian

Hogg had the vision of developing a facility capable of hosting first class cricket in Wollongong. The North Dalton Park Trust has done a tremendous job in conjunction with Wollongong City Council to continue to work on the ground to bring it up to the required standard. I thank everyone that has contributed over the past 20 years.

NSW is currently coached by Illawarra product Trent Johnston, whose career as a player with NSW and Ireland, and now as coach is something the Illawarra cricket community is very proud of.

Season 2016/17 now shapes a very busy and exciting one for Wollongong, with us hosting a 4 day Futures League (State 2nd XI) fixture in November, the Australian Country Championships in January and the Shield game in February.
